OriHime has a camera in its head, so its pilot can see people in front of the robot. The pilot can have a conversation via the robot's microphone and speaker. The pilot can even show emotions by moving the robot's head and arms.

The developer of OriHime, Yoshifuji Ory, believes that meeting new people is very important in our lives. For people who cannot go out easily, using an OriHime robot is a great way to meet people outside their home or hospital.

OriHime has a lot of uses. For example, a patient in the hospital now uses an OriHime robot to work as a company receptionist. Sick children who cannot leave their home or hospital can attend school events and make friends. We will surely see more examples of OriHime's uses in the future.
