One famous Vietnamese food is a rice noodle soup called *pho*. A lot of people in Vietnam have *pho* as breakfast. On their way to school or work, they drop by food stalls or restaurants to eat *pho*.

*Pho* noodles are made of rice. In fact, rice is very important in Vietnam, and it is eaten in many ways. People cook rice like Japanese people do. Vietnamese *okonomiyaki*, *bánh xèo*, contains some rice powder. Famous spring rolls use rice paper. This is because it is easier to grow rice in Vietnam. In Japan, rice is usually grown once a year, but in Vietnam they can grow rice three times a year because it is warm all year round. Vietnamese rice is not the same kind as Japanese. Japanese rice is round, but Vietnamese rice is narrow. Japanese rice is sticky when it is cooked, but Vietnamese rice is not.

What does carbon neutrality mean? It does not mean that we emit no carbon. It means that a certain amount of carbon is still emitted, but the same amount is absorbed elsewhere.

In order to achieve carbon neutrality, the Japanese government has decided to increase the number of cars that can run on electricity, such as EVs (electric vehicles), FCVs (fuel cell vehicles), and PHVs (plug-in hybrid vehicles). EVs run on electricity from batteries. The batteries can be charged at charging stations or at home. FCVs run on electricity generated by a chemical reaction between hydrogen and oxygen. FCVs have a hydrogen tank and use oxygen in the air. Both EVs and FCVs emit no carbon dioxide when they run. PHVs have both a battery and a gasoline engine. They run on electricity, but they can run on gasoline when they use up the electricity. PHVs don't produce as much carbon dioxide as gasoline cars when they run.

A big problem for the future of these cars is infrastructure. We will need a lot of charging stations in town. The cars that use hydrogen need hydrogen stations. It won't be easy to build enough stations throughout the country, but this must be done in order to achieve carbon neutrality.
