In 2013, it became a World Heritage site. Mt. Fuji, however, is a cultural rather than natural World Heritage site. This means that the mountain has cultural importance.

Mt. Fuji has a religious tradition. Mt. Fuji has been a sacred place for a long time. It is believed that the mountain became a place of religious training during the 12th century. It attracted more and more people after that. Climbing paths were made. Shrines were built. In the Edo period, a lot of people climbed the mountain for religious purposes.

Mt. Fuji's cultural importance can also be seen in art and literature. The mountain appears in famous art works such as those by Katsushika Hokusai. It also appears in a poem by Yamabeno Akahito. According to the well-known story *Taketori Monogatari*, the medicine of immortality was burned at the top of Mt. Fuji, so the mountain got the name "fu-ji" or "fu-shi." It means immortality in Japanese.

More than five million people visit Mt. Fuji every year. We have to protect the scenery and environment of this important mountain.
